At Mechanicsville Covered Bridge  
1359 Windsor Mechanicsville Road in Geneva  
Sunday, July 18, 2021

Twelve people arrived at various times; Joan, Elias, Ellen, Cindy, Terese & her friend, Bernie, Char, Alesha & Lilian, Rozenia & friend went to the Harpersfield Bridge. Lee spent 4 hours and 140 miles and never made it to the bridge. He was almost in PA!

The river was rushing and had flooded the banks by 6 to 8 feet. So, the Sketchers couldn't sit in the shade by the bank and ended up painting in full sun in the parking lot.
