Bernie Russ - a black & white photo was copied and placed on a mat board; colored with acrylics. Third image is 'cup & pie' cut out, glued and painted on a black mat board.





Char Dayton - enjoyed doing this assignment. Selected a photo from Nova Scotia...there are pieces of the photo throughout..notice the house with flowers. On watercolor paper, she painted the stream using acrylic paint and ink; for the birch trees and sky, she used sponges and bubble wrap.

Joan Milligan - printed a photo on card stock and painted over it using acrylics and modeling paste.
