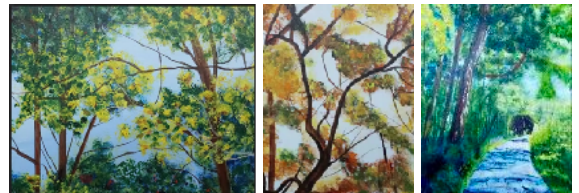
Char Dayton - Love is a kitty cat...their eyes especially radiate love. Even though she doesn't have a cat, she did it for her good friend living at Breckenridge. It's done in pencil with a little charcoal. Then, she bumped up the cat's eyes with color and shadowing.

Cheri Gardiner - She chose her landscape watercolor of two people sitting together staring out at the Oregon coast to which she added the quote from The Little Prince...“*Love does not consist in gazing at each other, but in looking together in the same direction.*”



Sue Herrle - Her watercolor depicts a Harmonic Convergence....a coming together in peace and love, called “We are One”....One equals Love!

Suzette Cohen - She did several acrylic paintings. Love is Fall Colors! Love is a Walk in the North Chagrin Park. She uses special brushes to get the effects of leaves on the trees. Suzette just loves the Metroparks and Acacia for all they have to offer. Her landscapes are painted from her photos.



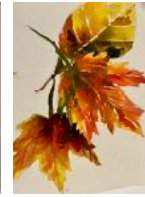
Vicki Ratliff - In Vicki's image, Love Is depicted in a more spiritual sense. There are four symbols - the heart, yin/yang, peace sign, and infinity. Notice the streaks of white light shining through. It's done with colored pencil and ink.

Deb Johnson - Love is family, which she depicts in her unfinished oil painting of penguins. Notice the love of baby and parent with family all around.
