PROGRAM

At our November meeting, local artist, **Jacques Payne** will demonstrate "**The Art of Glass Mosaic**". The glass mosaic is one of his art forms...wood another favorite. Jacques, a Cleveland native, is the son of two artists. His love affair with art started in Jr. High School with woodworking and continued as he attended Hawken School in Gates Mills. During college at Grambling State University and The Art Institute of Atlanta, Jacques used his artistic skills designing decorative paddles, advertisements, and wearable clothing for Greek letter organizations. Later, he developed a love for both Egyptian symbols and the Adinkra symbols of Ghana. These Afrocentric symbols are the primary themes depicted in his woodworking, mosaic glass art, paintings, jewelry, and home décor.
