NOVEMBER PROGRAM - WE WILL HAVE ONE!

It will be **Monday, November 2 at 7:00p.m.** Mark your calendar, please. Award winning local artist, **Sally Heston**, will present a live ZOOM watercolor demonstration. She will demo "*Creating a Foggy Scene in the Landscape*" using wet on wet watercolor technique. With all the wildfires out west, we also asked if she would talk about capturing the effects of 'smoke' in the atmosphere.

More about Sally. . . She works primarily in watercolor, pastel, and acrylics. She holds a BS degree in Art Education from Indiana University of PA and a Master of Education degree in Art from the University of Pittsburgh. She is a retired art teacher with over 30 years of teaching experience. She currently teaches painting classes at the Cuyahoga Valley Art Center. As a signature member of the Ohio Watercolor Society, the Pennsylvania Watercolor Society, and the Whiskey Painters of America, she participates in numerous group art exhibits and has won many awards for her work. Her work is included in private collections locally and throughout the United States and Europe. Her biography is included in *Who's Who in American Women* and her work is included in *Splash 8: Watercolor Discoveries* published by North Light Books.

We hope you enjoyed the first SKB video offering (as outlined in our October newsletter) featuring artist, Jan Martin McGuire, *An Artist in Africa*. Did you get to see it? We have **two new video offerings** for this month:

First, **Tom Lucas**, "Without Great Light, You Have Nothing". Having been raised in a Native American culture, Tom says it allows him to put some soul into his art. He will share his techniques as he does a still life, with a focus on light and depth. "I want you to feel as though you can actually reach right into the painting." They have a list of artwork from the museum. Clicking on the piece of art takes you to another page. You will learn all about the artist and that piece of artwork. You choose one that inspires you to draw something. You can then submit a photo of your artwork to the museum. The museum may pick your art to be posted on their Instagram page. It's like Facebook, but no ads.
