FEBRUARY PROGRAM

We'll be Zooming our next monthly meeting on **Monday, February 1, 2021 at 7:00p.m.** featuring a watercolor demonstration by well known North East Ohio artist, **Rick Surowicz**. We are in for a BIG surprise. Whatever Rick decides to demonstrate in watercolor will definitely be fun to watch and a learning experience for us all....as many of you know who have participated in his YouTube watercolor channel. In 2017 he launched his YouTube channel "Rick Surowicz Watercolor". It was selected by Feedspot.com as one of the top 75 watercolor painting YouTube channels, placing it 8th on their list. His channel, recently mentioned in Watercolor Artist Magazine, has now surpassed 35,000 subscribers and has over 2 million views.

"To look where others don't look, to see what others don't see, to say without saying inspires and challenges me as an artist. I look through underbrush to see the river. I see beyond the flower to behold the foliage and suggest the tree by painting the woods. I seek to portray that which is not obvious. It's not my intent to replicate but to interpret through the elements and principles of design. I enjoy the beauty of transparent watercolor and continue to learn and evolve with every painting, with every brushstroke."

Rick discovered how much he enjoyed the challenges of watercolor in 1992. "I experimented with different mediums before settling into watercolor. I love both the freedom and the challenge of working with transparent watercolor." His paintings have been juried into the National and International exhibitions of The American Watercolor Society, Transparent Watercolor Society of America, Louisiana Watercolor Society, Georgia Watercolor Society, Ohio Watercolor Society, and Splash 21. Rick is a signature member of the Ohio Watercolor Society and was recently elected to one of the Trustee positions.
