LAKE METROPARKS FARMPARK FALL FINE ART SHOW, SEPTEMBER 19 - OCTOBER 15, 2023

It's time to enter the SHOW! Your art will be on display in their beautiful hallway art gallery which gets lots of foot traffic during the fall season. Highlighting key points, all of which are detailed in the Instructions:

- All forms, including the show instructions are now available on EuclidArt.com, [Art Shows page](#). Go there to print them out. *A special e-blast with all forms attached will be emailed to you soon.*
- Deadline to enter is **Wednesday, August 30**. Along with your completed entry form and \$20 nonrefundable check, you must also print, sign and send the Lake Farmpark(LFP) Loan Agreement.
- You can enter 3 pieces of art. LFP takes a 20% commission. EAA takes none. Price your work accordingly.
- The Monday dates of September 18 and October 16 are the drop off and pickup days, respectively.
- Cash awards will only be given for Best of Show and 1st Place. Amounts will be determined based on the number of entries.
- The artist reception is Thursday, September 21 from 6:00 p.m. - 8:00 p.m. EAA will provide a 'Cookies and Punch' reception in the lobby of the entrance to Lake Farmpark. Cash awards and ribbons will be given at that time. Everyone is invited.
- LFP's admission policy after the reception: *"During daytime visitation, we will allow one visit for the exhibitor only, during the dates of the art show; however, all other visitors/guests of artists admission will apply. Open Tuesday through Sunday, 9 am to 5 pm."*
