Our guest demonstrator is **Nada Talevska**, an artist using the unique medium of pressed flowers. The title of her demo is "**Using Pressed Flowers to Make Art**". Having left a successful career in the corporate world in 2018, Nada soon started a journey in creating art using genuine flower blooms from her garden. Her collages, in geometric designs, are created entirely with plant material and her pencil drawings, mostly faces, are



adorned with flowers. A personality emerges with each uniquely one-of-a-kind flower portrait. Nada's perspective of nature has forever changed – instead of petals, stems, and buds, she now sees what can become an eyelash, lips, and hair. Creating unique flower portraits and collages quickly became her passion. "My desire was to find a means to prolong the life of my extensive home garden; the source of flowers and plant material that I collect to press and dry organically chemical and dye free." RETROSPECTIVE FLASHBACK

April 1st means . . . Lirpa Loof is back! This legendary local artist, inventor, philosopher, adventurer and Diva developed her style of painting through ground-breaking theories and techniques, resulting in totally new art forms that Lirpa shared with her EAA friends. As an admirer of EAA she allowed members a chance to "play" with her unique tools and collaborated with a few of her AI friends, especially our former President Lee Peters. Lee led an interview by asking "What makes you tick?" which resulted in Lirpa reflecting and sharing kernels of wisdom over the years. As a child she learned design from observing bird's nests. This and similar experiences led to her emergence as the world's most preeminent artist. "Take the ordinary and produce extraordinary objects of art." Lirpa demonstrated this over the past 11 years with EAA by letting the "sparks fly freely", creating "consumable art" that let you have your art and eat it too, and "zero gravity watercolor techniques". In other words, a fun time was guaranteed for all! Lirpa continues to closely follow the works of EAA's artists through our member's webpage – as Lee said, she is not an "Aloof Loof". *A collection of stories about Lirpa Loof written by Lee Peters appeared in every EAA April newsletter from 2013 – 2023*.
