#### PROGRAM: "Intellectual Property Issues for Artists"

We have a very special program scheduled for the evening. We welcome back Michael W. Vary, Attorney at Law. Many members expressed interest in how to protect one's artwork, copyright it, legal concerns using someone else's photo reference for artwork, and what to be aware of when painting famous people. Michael is the one to answer these questions for us. His experiences include patents, copyright and trademark litigation with a focus on Intellectual Property protection and counseling. Michael has lectured and taught intellectual property law as an adjunct professor at Case Western Reserve University School of Law, formerly practicing law at McCarthy, Lebit, Crystal & Liffman.
