ELIGIBILITY Current **paid** members (July 1, 2022, to June 30, 2023) of the Euclid Art Association.

REGISTRATION

All entry forms must be received by **Thursday, November 10, 2022**. Any entry form received after that date will not be accepted. Due to limitation of gallery space, first come, first served.

ENTRY RULES

All work **must be properly framed, wired and ready to hang**. Gallery wrapped canvases with wires accepted. **No hanging hooks – wired only! No wet paintings!**

Any original artwork that represents the theme is acceptable, including art previously exhibited with Euclid Art Association.

Entries must have two (2) labels. One identification label securely attached to the back of the picture or bottom of the sculpture and second label loosely attached to the front of the entry for easy removal. (No Scotch tape.) The labels will include artist's name, title, medium and price. This **MUST** match the info on your Entry Form. **NO CHANGES** can be made regarding price or title after entry forms are submitted.

Any work deemed objectionable to the integrity of the show will not be accepted.

EAA reserves the right to use any of the entries for promotional purposes.

ENTRY LIMIT

One work per artist. A second item may be included if there is space, at the discretion of the board.

ENTRY DELIVERY AND LOCATION

Entries must be taken to the **EUCLID PUBLIC LIBRARY**, 631 East 222nd Street on **Thursday, December 1, 2022, between 10:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. ONLY**. Although all precautions will be taken in handling the artwork, Euclid Public Library and Euclid Art Association will not be responsible for damage or theft.

COMMISSION

All sales will be made payable to Euclid Art Association. Checks will be issued to the artist, less 15% commission, within three weeks after end of show.

PICKUP DATE

Tuesday, January 31, 2023, from 10:00 to 11:00 a.m. **ONLY!** The Euclid Art Association and Euclid Public Library will not be responsible for any artwork left after that time

Points to Remember: NO groups or sets for this show.

- **Size matters.** EAA wants to fill the EPL Art Gallery hallway, but it is a limited space.
- **Please indicate the size of your framed art, vertical (up and down) first and then horizontal measurement.**
- **A second work of art can be considered. You will be notified if space is available when all entry info has been received.**
- **On the other hand, if it appears that entries at some point will fill the space, members will be notified that no more can be accepted.**

Please send a digital copy of your work so EAA can determine the assembly of the exhibit. This will NOT be used for a virtual show.

Delivery of digital images to mickmesh@aol.com

- **Look at phone or device to choose small, medium, large, or actual message or image size. Send large or actual. Contact Lee Peters (216-531-6349) if image won't go.**
- **Use title of art as the as the image file name.**
- **Avoid uneven lighting or glare. Shoot art against plain background. Avoid skewed angles.**

- **When actual art is delivered to the library on December 1, artist or representative will sign a form indicating that the Euclid Public Library and/or the Euclid Art Association will not be held responsible for damage or theft.**
